- (i) Marks scored by candidates in the Computer Based Examination will be normalized (If required) by using the formula published by DSSSB vide Notice No. 10 (271)/Sec.Cell/DSSSB/18/989 dated 11.07.2018 (**Annexure-II**) and such normalized scores shall be used to determine final merit and selection. Final selection will be done as per examination scheme given in Para 4. Final merit list shall be prepared by the Delhi High Court itself.
- (ii) In case of any question(s) appearing in the exam are held to be invalid, those questions will not be evaluated and the marks scored by the candidate will be calculated on prorated basis (out of maximum marks).
