## INVITES APPLICATIONS FOR SHORT SERVICE COMMISSION OFFICERS FOR VARIOUS ENTRIES - JUN 2027 (AT 27) COURSE



Apply Online from – 25 Jun 26

Last date for Online Application – 27 Jul 26

1. Applications are invited from eligible unmarried men and unmarried women candidates for grant of Short Service Commission (SSC) for course commencing Jun 2027 onwards at Indian Naval Academy (INA) Ezhimala, Kerala. Candidates must fulfill conditions as laid out below by the Government of India.

**Note (1)** Training vacancies mentioned above are tentative and may be changed depending on availability of training slots.

- Multiple entries are not permitted.
- Submarine Arm.**
- Selected candidates will be detailed to specialised submarine service duties and would be required to undergo further specialised training.
- Submarine stowage and other applicable conditions post successful completion of submarine arm training would be as per extant rules.
- Only serving officers in Merchant of India, Ministry of Shipping & Transport Certificate of Competency (Foreign going) either as a Second Mate, Mate or Master and born between 02 Jul 2002 to 01 Jan 2006 (both dates inclusive) are eligible for Naval Constructor entry.
- Candidates applying for pilot entry should possess valid and current Commercial Pilot License issued by the Government of India as per extant rules.
- Candidates holding valid and current Air Traffic Controller License issued by DGCA, Ministry of Civil Aviation valid till 01 Jan 2006 (both dates inclusive) can apply for Air Traffic Controller (ATC) entry.
- Retired personnel of Indian Armed Forces are also eligible.
- Having NCC 'C' certificate or Naval Army Air Wing with minimum 'B' Grade.
- Candidates must be able to endure the rigours of sea, a demanding life style and willing to serve anywhere in India as well as outside India.
- No civil employment is permissible while serving in the Navy.

**Note (2)** This notification is subject to change and the candidates are advised to check the website of the Indian Navy at [www.joinindiannavy.gov.in](http://www.joinindiannavy.gov.in) for all updates on eligibility conditions and other details.

**3. How to Apply.**

- Candidates who have obtained degree (graduate) post-graduate or are in the final year.
- Candidate degree should have been obtained from a University incorporated by an Act of Central or State Legislature in India or other educational institutions established by an Act of Parliament or declared to be deemed as University under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956 or AICTE Act, 1987, or Institute of National Importance or an Institution of National Importance or any other educational institution recognized by the Government of India as equivalent to above.
- Candidate should be physically and medically fit as per medical standards applicable to entry branches.

**Note (3)** The candidate will be required to fulfill the educational qualification stipulated above before joining INA, Ezhimala by Jun 2027.

- The candidate is to be unmarried while submitting the online application.
- All SSC branches are not eligible to apply for pilot entry.
- Candidates must indicate their preference for other branches/ cadres also, if they wish to be considered for those branches/ cadres.
- Applications will not be considered in cases of multiple entries.
- No equivalent stream/course will be considered as per the educational qualification.
- No backlog supplementary in BE/B.Tech or MCA are to be considered for selection process at any stage.
- Candidates will be deemed to appear for SSC if any backlog in any subject is pending at the time of document verification of SSC centre.

**Note (4)** Medical Examination Procedure, Merit Detail & Medical Standards.

- Specified number of candidates based on service requirement, who have chosen SSC Pilot entry will be considered for Stage-I/II/III as per selection procedure of individual entry.
- Candidates declared medically unfit for induction as per laid down medical standards or any other reason are liable to be rejected. No appeal is permissible.
- Candidates are advised to get their ears cleaned for wax, and if suffering from auritis or any medical problems, get them treated well in time.
- Candidate should report to SSB with correct visual power, be free from colour blindness and wear suitable spectacles if required.
- No request for change of Medical Review Board will be entertained to consider a candidate.
- Change of SSB Centre for interview is not permissible under any circumstances.
- Any communication regarding changes of SSB date/ time will be conveyed on candidate's email id.
- On closing interview, a final medical examination will be conducted at INS Chitra and only those candidates who are declared medically fit will be issued joining instructions.
- Medical insurance of Rs. 8 lakhs will be applicable for candidates for the entire duration of training.

**(B) Selection Procedure.** The selection procedure is as follows:-

- Shortlisting will be application wise based on marks obtained by the candidate in the qualifying degree. Marks obtained by the candidates in the qualifying degree will be normalized using formula mentioned in Join Indian Navy website (URL - <https://www.joinindiannavy.gov.in/indian-navy/ssc/>).
- BE/B.Tech. For candidates who have completed or are in the final year of BE/B.Tech, marks obtained by both semesters will be considered for SSB shortlisting. For candidates who are in final year, shortlisting will be based on marks till pre-final year.
- Post-Graduate Degree For candidates who have completed or are in the final year, MA, MCA, MEd, B.Tech, marks obtained in all semesters will be considered.
- SSC for pilot entry. Marks obtained in all semesters/ years till pre-final year.
- Candidates will be shortlisted for SSB based on their rank in merit and as per the number of vacancies.
- Change of SSB centre for interview is not permitted to join the pilot entry. However, in exceptional cases, a request for change of centre may be considered.
- Candidates appearing for the Education entry must have scored minimum of 60% marks in class X and class XII and minimum 60% marks in English in class X and XII.
- Change of SSB Centre for interview is not permissible under any circumstances.
- Any communication regarding changes of SSB date/ time will be conveyed on candidate's email id.
- On closing interview, a final medical examination will be conducted at INS Chitra and only those candidates who are declared medically fit will be issued joining instructions.
- No request for change of Medical Review Board will be entertained to consider a candidate.
- Medical insurance of Rs. 8 lakhs will be applicable for candidates for the entire duration of training.

**6. Training.**

- Candidates will be inducted in the rank of Sub Lieutenant subject to clearing of induction medical examination at INA, Ezhimala post reporting.
- Only unmarried candidates are eligible for training. Any candidate found to be in a relationship or indulging in inappropriate behaviour (like indecent talk or act) towards any female during training shall be liable to return full pay and allowances drawn by him/her and other expenditure incurred on the candidate during entire training period.
- If the officer voluntarily withdraws from initial training or refuses to continue training, liable that an amount equal to the cost of training is whole or in part, as may be determined by the competent authority. The amount to be refunded will be recovered from the officer's pay and allowances and with interest as decided by Govt of India.
- Candidates found guilty of misconduct during training are liable for punitive action as decided by competent authority which may include imprisonment and/or dismissal from the service.

**7. Important:** Mere issue of call up letter to SSB marks for all entries as per availability of vacancies and medical clearance for respective entry. Candidates declared fit in medical examination get permission for further process.

**Note (B) More points.**

- Mere issue of call-up letter does not confer any entitlement right or create any vested right to appointment.
- Candidates may also note that mere appointment is under no circumstances to be treated as final select and is not an irrevocable claim to post applied for.

**8. Disqualification.** Candidate disqualified at any stage of selection or found not suitable by the Indian Navy on any ground will be considered for any other entry.

- Candidates are advised not to furnish any false information.
- If any candidate is found to have furnished incorrect information or concealment of information, his/her candidature is liable to be cancelled at any stage of selection process or even after selection and the candidate is liable to be prosecuted in a court of law.

**9. General Information.** Details regarding pay & allowances, training period, leave, terms & conditions of service and other benefits will be available on Indian Navy website [www.joinindiannavy.gov.in](http://www.joinindiannavy.gov.in)

**Note (7)** Please note that the notification is only a notification for selection process and not for appointment. Appointment is subject to service requirement, performance, medical eligibility and willingness of candidates. Candidates are to take note that their internet data credentials (email & mobile number) are to be kept active from the date of submission of application till enlistment as all official communication will be sent on the registered email id and mobile number.

**Note (8)** The application once submitted will not be allowed for amendments/changes.

**Note (9)** Your candidature will be permanently cancelled and action can be initiated against you online application.

- Your candidature will be permanently cancelled and action can be initiated against you online application.
- Your possession of any concealed information with intent to mislead the organization.
- Your possession or use of malicious code or other harmful programmes in the body during SSB's medical.
- Your application is liable to be rejected if found INELIGIBLE/INVALID at any point of time.
